

Recruitment for the post of Research Assistant

Applications are invited from the interested candidates for **TWO** posts of Research Assistants under Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D), Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, sponsored research project titled "Critical analysis of effectiveness of CCTV in law enforcement (crime prevention, detection, Traffic Management etc.) in six major cities of India viz Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai, Chennai, Surat and Bengaluru" No: 32/07/2018-RD.

The staff will be appointed initially for 11 months (purely on temporary basis) and the services may be extended till the end of the project based on the performance review.

First class with not less than 60% aggregate (or) not less than 6.5 CGPA on a 10 point scale in MBA/MCA from a recognized University/ Institution.
	Preference will be given to UGC-NET/JRF qualified candidates.
Duration	Initially for 11 months (purely on temporary basis)
Consolidated salary	Fellowship of Rs.16,000/- per month
Age limit	Not exceeding 32 years on the last date of receipt of applications
