The institute is going to conduct a walk-in-interview in offline mode (written test and interview) for the post of Teaching Assistants (purely on ad-hoc basis for 11 months) in the Department of Electronics Engineering on **30th June 2022** (Reference: No. DECE/ODD/TA Requirement/359/2022-23 dated: 06/06/2022).

- The candidate is requested to remain present with a filled application in the prescribed form only along with original supporting documents such as degree certificates, semester- wise marks sheets, experience certificates, testimonials, etc. and one set of *self-attested* copy of the same documents at 8:30 am in the department of electronics engineering on **30th June 2022 (Thursday)**. For the same level of performance, preference will be given to the reserved category and PwD category candidates.
- Any wrong or misleading information supplied by the candidate may lead to summarily rejection of the application/appointment, if found subsequently.
- Applications on plain paper or incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Additional Instructions

The candidates who will be visiting the campus on **30th June 2022**, to appear in the written tests, presentations and interviews for the post of Teaching Assistants are required to note the following:

1. Report to the department well before the beginning of the Registration. For example, the Registration is at 8:30 am, then you have to report on or before 8.30 am.
2. Keep in mind the COVID-19 measures and follow the guidelines issued by the central/state/local administration and the institute. You have to wear face masks, keep your physical distance, and maintain personal hygiene.
3. Don't move in groups and don't involve in any talks or discussions.
4. You have to leave the campus immediately, if you are not short-listed after the Document Verification/Written Test.
5. A vaccination certificate is necessary for the candidates.
